

Tunisian Higher Education Institutions

Public HEIs:

- 13 universities
- 01 Directorate General of Technological studies
- 203 higher institutes, faculties, schools of engineering and Higher Institute of Technological Studies

Private HEIs:

• 65 higher institutes, faculties, schools of engineering

- -Governance, strategic planning and management of higher education institutions (including human resources and financial management)
- -Internationalization of higher education institutions (including recognition mechanisms and mobility, international relations capacities)
- -Quality assurance process and mechanisms





• Category D: Developing of Higher Education sector within society at large (Valid for Joint Projects and Structural Projects)

Subject areas:

- -University-Enterprise cooperation, employability of graduates
- -Knowledge triangle, innovation (reinforcing links between education, research and business)
- -Development of the higher education sector in the regions within the country
- -Definition, implementation and monitoring of the reform policies






Tunisia's involvement in Erasmus Mundus, Tempus and Erasmus+





Erasmus Mundus (2007-2013) 17 projects








Tempus III (2002-2006) 31 projects






