Why a course on mentoring teachers?

Mentoring teachers in schools can be an effective mechanism to help teachers bridge the gap between theory and practice, and can increase their job satisfaction and feeling of self-efficacy. This, in turn, positively affects student learning. While the effectiveness of mentoring to a large extent depends on the mentor's skills and characteristics, mentors often are appointed following their teaching experience without receiving much guidance for the mentoring relationships.
