



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Digital solutions and lifelong guidance

The ICT solutions can be broadly divided into two groups:

- service provision, including web pages, databases, educational software, games, social media channels, and e-tests
- **internal processes**, including documentation management, customer management, feedback solutions, information exchange, and elearning environments.






Interactive career centre in Tallinn


