Ukrainian dental students can take part in practical and theoretical courses at Danube Private University during short-term stays. These are stays with a maximum duration of 7 days, whereby special interest courses can be organized for the students (either in German, English or Russian). The Danube Private University has previously organised a series of extracurricular courses for students and young dentists from Ukraine, training them in the field of digital dentistry and periodontology. Due to the relatively high costs of the course materials, these courses are not completely free of charge, but the fee is a small amount. Faculty members of Ukrainian universities have the opportunity to participate in practical pre-clinical courses at Danube Private University as tutors for local students over a longer period of time (several weeks or months). While their stay, the Ukrainian colleagues will assist a course instructor in enhancing students' practical abilities by actively assisting students in the internalisation of the practical steps of dental treatment, which are simulated on a phantom head. The colleagues will assist in the supervision of live demonstrations and will also demonstrate the practical steps in a one-to-one setting. The language of instruction is German, although English is understood by all students and course tutors. In addition, there is the possibility of a research stay if a scientific cooperation with a Ukrainian university is established.

 We have several ideas for cooperation with researchers from Ukrainian universities. We also see an opportunity to develop joint (or national) Unique Selling Points that will help position our partners (as well as our university) on the international arena. For instance: We are interested in joint research projects related to management in for- and non-profit sectors. Especially, we would like to learn more about strategies to cope with turbulent environments, about mental health (e.g. burnout) of employees and managers, as well as digital innovation under condition of high uncertainty. We are eager and willing to conduct joint studies with Ukrainian researchers and advance science with knowledge about firms, health care institutions, or other organisations which have to act in the conditions of running warfare. We are also interested in knowledge and experience of working with cyber threats and digital warfare. As Ukraine became a battle arena for cyber adversaries, the country has shown advancement and can help other European countries face this challenge. We see potential for investigation of turbulent environments. This allows for advancements in dynamic capabilities research as well as research on systematic (enterprise) risk management. As a tourism region, the federal state of Tyrol and the MCI in particular are interested in cooperation in this domain. Although we see the limitation in the tourist capacity due to the war, we may have an experience exchange for after-war tourism development in Ukraine.

The Faculty of Psychotherapy at Sigmund Freud University is open to participation in international research collaborations in order to support and implement the European idea of cross-border education. As a truly cross-border university, SFU welcomes student mobility from the UA and is also interested in participating in various staff mobility programmes. Our recently submitted project in Horizon EU will look at how reactionary, identitarian and extremist (RIE) movements and politics have emerged in Europe in recent years, with an alarming increase in the radicalisation of young men. Many of these ideals and politics develop in online forums and platforms - often seen as tools of radicalisation - and are then passed on in everyday social circles and disseminated by political channels used as a very effective propaganda weapon in Russia's war against Ukraine. In an effort to understand and counter these trends, UNMASC aims to examine the specific construction and representation of masculinity in RIE movements in order to provide a comprehensive interpretation of the recent rise of RIE politics and radicalisation based on a multidisciplinary, trauma-informed approach.

Higher education in Ukraine has been in demand for modernisation and improvement already before the start of the current war in 2022, but now its need for support on many levels, including support of its young people and future professionals through education is even more important than before. Crucial points of development in the fields of architecture and construction include not only the rapidly growing trends that go in line with the EU Sustainable Development Goals, such as Green Deal, energy efficiency, zero emissions, etc., but also a massive demand for a sustainable reconstruction and rebuilding of the country that is going to arise after the end of the war. Therefore, we would like to target the competencies of the Ukrainian future professionals in the fields of architecture and construction through projects that would support Ukrainian partner universities to bring their higher education level to the EU standards and help their future professionals become competitive on the EU labour market. The needs of the Ukrainian universities that have been identified so far and that must be targeted within future projects can be summarised as following: - Green skills in connection with the Green Deal: there is a demand in Ukraine not only to raise the awareness of					
 general population on the topics of sustainability, energy efficiency, zero emission goals, climate neutrality, etc., but also to strengthen the offer of its higher education institutions and update the university curricula to the relevant topics in line with the Sustainable Development Goals. Digital skills: there is a long-term problem of professional licenced software (CAD, BIM, etc.) being not affordable neither for individual students, nor for universities. Therefore, the project will aim at providing the Ukrainian partners with necessary licenced software, that will go in line with workshops for both Ukrainian teachers and students. Modernisation: up-to-date devices for digital documentation, monitoring and measurement of built structures (drones, airborne and terrestrial laser scanners, etc.) for educational purposes have been unaffordable for the Ukrainian universities, but now has become a crucial point for the future rebuilding of Ukraine. Therefore, it is planned to provide Ukrainian partners with necessary measurement devises, that will go in line with

This strand of cooperation, being pursued by the Department for Legal Studies and International Relations under Prof. DDr. Thomas Ratka, LL.M., will bear particular significance in light of the European Council's decision in December 2023 to open accession negotiations with Ukraine. I would be very much interested in developing joints projects on using sport activities as a means of building relationships, social networks and cross-community relations at a grassroots level. In doing so, I would like to build on my experiences and knowledge from previously conducted projects. For example, a recently finished qualitative study examined the current situation on the role of organized sports in supporting integration of refugees from violent conflict zones (man-made disasters). It focussed on how sports clubs supported a sense of belonging, building bridges and promoting systematic integration into networks in Tyrol, Austria. Another study explored the structural conditions that help refugees get access to the organized sports setting, the conditions that influence the integration into club life and the characteristic features that help or impede the clubs' ability to moderate the refugees' integration into society. And finally, an (Erasmus plus) project of mine focussed on how sports activities could be a coping mechanism for unaccompanied and separated children and how other sports club members support these children in their personal development and acculturation process to a new society. I offer my collaboration with students, universities, healthcare institutions, and industry. The primary focus of this effort is on prosthetics development and prosthetic care, enabling young people to sustainably address both the infrastructural problems and the shortage of qualified professionals in Ukraine.						
To meet the quality standards in education, I can regularly send used prostheses to Ukraine from AUVA (the first delivery of prostheses took place in December 2023). I am willing to engage in practical work on specific topics (bachelor's theses, master's theses, doctoral theses) due to current circumstances and share the results.							
At the University of Applied Sciences Upper Austria (FH OÖ), I hold a fixed teaching and research position as part of a 50% part-time employment as follows: Monday (08:00 - 17:00), Tuesday (08:00 - 17:00), Thursday (08:00 - 12:00). Within this 50% part-time role, a project duration of up to 5 years is possible for me. However, a project duration of three years seems reasonable, since a bachelor's degree program also has this duration. The project could be carried out in a block format, requiring approximately three two-day blocks per semester. The individual block sessions within the project can partly be conducted in a hybrid format, but some presence in Ukraine is essential—especially for acquiring and consolidating practical knowledge.

EU/Erasmus+ funded project EdUkraine: This project is based on a collaboration between the University of Education Upper Austria (PH OÖ), three Ukrainian universities, the Education Directorate of Upper Austria, and six schools in the region. Since October 2023, eight Ukrainian students have been completing a full-time internship at six primary and secondary schools in Upper Austria where they support Austrian teachers in teaching (displaced) Ukrainian students. As part of the project, we also plan to invite Ukrainian experts to Austria for a scientific exchange. These experts will discuss relevant issues and contribute to improving the learning conditions of the students, including the psychosocial situation of some children. To investigate the living and learning conditions of Ukrainian children in Austrian schools, interviews will also be conducted with Ukrainian children and parents. As the Ukrainian students are working in schools, they have a good access to these relevant players. Additionally, Austrian teachers at the participating schools will be interviewed. The learning and living environment of the Ukrainian students will be exploratively examined through interviews with the parents and through participatory observations. The research results will be published. While working in this project providing educational and individual support for Ukrainian refugee children and adolescents in Upper Austrian schools, we have encountered an issue we call "the lost generation." Ukrainian						
adolescents in Upper Austrian schools, we have encountered an issue we call "the lost generation." Ukrainian refugee adolescents aged 11-14 often end up in German support classes in Austrian middle schools, but the time is often too short for them to grasp the language well. Many of these adolescents, aged 14-15, will soon finish middle school with limited German skills, severely restricting their future opportunities in work and education. While the Education Directorate in Upper Austria offers support and placement assistance, we have considered alternative solutions. With around 200 Austrian companies still operating in Ukraine, we propose vocational programs where these companies train apprentices in Austria for employment in Ukraine. We already train teachers for vocational schools at our University of Education Upper Austria, and with the support and expertise of our Austrian vocational school teachers and teacher trainers, apprentices could be trained in both Ukrainian and German. After completing their training, these apprentices could return to Ukraine and work for these companies, addressing the skills gap and potentially contributing to Ukraine's reconstruction. This approach not only provides education for Ukrainian adolescents but also addresses the brain drain issue and supports Ukraine's development.
